ACTIVITIES LIST

This is a draft of the activities that we have planned for our six days in the rugged West. We will almost certainly add some more and we may have to delete one or two, but we think not. We hope you will approve of our choice of activities and enjoy them. They are listed in no particular order.

1. We plan to take a ferry to the ARAN ISLANDS, more specifically INIS MÓR (The big Island). On INIS MÓR we will be driven, in a coach, to the most popular attractions. Lunch will be available on the Island, but you have to pay for your choices.
2. We will take a cruise on KILLARY FJORD, Ireland's largest Fjord at ten miles long. The scenery on this cruise is absolutely stunning.
3. We will visit KYLEMORE ABBEY. In 1850 Mitchell Henry, (Doctor, Industry Tycoon, Politician and Pioneer) visited Connemara while on honeymoon. His wife Margaret Vaughan was so charmed by Connemara that her husband returned and bought the 15,000 acre estate as a romantic gift for her and created one of Ireland's most iconic castles. Nice gift!!!
4. We will have a Theatre Show by The Curlew Theatre Group, of Eamon Grennan's anthropological study of the people's lives, their habits and their folk tales etc., taken from John Millington Synge's work "The Aran Islands". Dinner will be after the show. This Theatre Show will be on the evening before we visit Inis Mór.
5. One evening, after dinner, there will be an exhibition of Irish Dancing by World Champion Irish Dancers from the Curley School of Irish Dancing.

6. We will visit the memorial site close to where John Alcock and Arthur Brown landed their Vickers Vimy Rolls - Royce powered aircraft, for the first non-stop transatlantic crossing in June 1919.

8. We will have a prosecco and canapés reception with some delightful fresh Connemara oysters, provided by the Renvyle Hotel. During the Reception we will be entertained in music by the talented Kane Sisters.
